## **Grade X Board Results**

Representatives from 44 universities from India and abroad had put up stalls and around 700 students from various schools and colleges visited the stalls. Students gained clarity on NEP-driven changes, emerging careers, entrance exams, vocational choices and skill-based pathways. This was a turning point for many young learners in understanding their strengths and aspirations.

They also had an exclusive session on SAT exam and its benefits for those aspiring to go abroad for their Under Graduation

## **Positive Affirmations**

The CBSE directed all the schools to include positive affirmations in their daily morning assembly routines from the academic session 2025-2026. The purpose of this exercise was to support the socio-emotional development of students, to instil a positive and respectful school culture, to encourage self-reflection and emotional regulation and to help students start their day with clarity, calm, and confidence. ## **Study skills programme**

To ensure that students stayed focused and worked hard a 5-day Study Skills Programme was conducted by the Entercon Edu Company for the students of Grades 10 & 12 at our school campus from 8<sup>th</sup> September to 12<sup>th</sup> September. The program helped students overcome addiction to screen time, realise their negatives, understand their potential and to start working towards realizing their dreams. The Parent's session and the teacher's session that followed enabled the adults to help them through this phase of life. A few handpicked teachers were appointed as mentors to these students for constant follow up. It was a very successful program and we are hoping to reap its results in the coming Board exam
