At Blue gems Montessori, we firmly believe in continuous learning, not only for our students but also for our educators. This year, our teachers participated in the Faculty Development Programme in May, enhancing their ability to create enriched learning experiences. Additionally, all our faculty members attend online workshops conducted by the various Montessorians of the IMF, broadening their knowledge and expertise.

On 24th and 25th of July 2025, an Orientation programme for parents of Level 1 and Level 3 of Primary Montessori and Level 1 of Elementary was conducted and Ms. Nancy, an experienced AMI trainer from Poland was invited to speak. She provided our Montessori parents with clarity and confidence about their child's educational journey in the Montessori way.

She highlighted on how Practical life and Sensorial activities form the basis for logical thinking and future mathematics, while simple home chores enhance fine motor skills for pre-writing.

Ms.Nancy emphasized that in Montessori, no area stands alone—each connects seamlessly to support the child's psychological needs. Primary activities prepare for Elementary, which is its natural extension.

As children master concrete materials, they transition effortlessly to abstraction, ensuring deep understanding and lifelong learning skills.

Parents appreciated the roadmap thus provided towards independence, confidence, and holistic development of the child.

DOCTOR'S TALK:

Promoting health and hygiene has been a core focus this year. We organized a series of Doctor's Talks in August and September, where medical professionals who are doctors from our parent community educated our children on essential topics like hygiene, dental care, and healthy eating habits. ASSEMBLIES:

Our Montessori students explored the theme - Coco melon through dedicated assemblies. In the Fun and exploration Assembly by the Lavender Environment, children demonstrated the theme through a skit, a song and experiments. In the Friendship and Social skills Assembly by the Lemon Environment children showcased the importance of social skills and friendship through their performance. An assembly on Daily Routine by the students of the Honeydew environment, highlighted their daily routines both in home and school. During the Fun learning and education Assembly by the Crimson Environment, a skit was performed by the students to depict fun learning, followed by a few interactive games. As a part of the Healthy food habits and good manners Assembly by the Melon Environment students highlighted the theme through a skit and song. The assembly on Family by the students of Indigo described

the nuclear and joint family and demonstrated the importance of joint family. Through these assemblies, we aim to build a strong emotional foundation in our children.

EDU SPORTS AND YOGA:

This year too, we continued with Edu sports by Sports Village, a structured physical education program which was conducted twice a week. Yoga Classes were introduced for Level 3 and Elementary students, fostering mindfulness and inner discipline.

WATER PLAY AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

An optional Water play activity was also conducted every Friday under professional guidance. Additionally, our Sustainable Development Project assigned each Montessori and Elementary environment a patch of land to cultivate vegetables, fostering responsibility and environmental consciousness among our students.

WATER BELL:

To encourage everyone in school to drink water, music is played for a minute, every one hour in both the blocks and water intake has improved considerably.

At Bluegems Montessori, we take pride in fostering creativity, critical thinking, and self-discipline, laying the foundation for holistic development. The Montessori approach nurtures not only academic excellence but also essential life skills that prepare children for the future. Our carefully planned infrastructure enables the children to work comfortably, and the learning happens in our happy, well-planned and well-equipped six Montessori environments, each designed to nurture the children's holistic development. These include Lavender, Lemon, Honeydew, Crimson, Melon, and Indigo environments, where students engage in hands-on learning, guided exploration, and self-paced discovery. Additionally, our Elementary Montessori students work in the Aquamarine, Olive and Saffron environments, where they build on their foundational learning through an advanced, research-based curriculum guided by trained teachers who guide the children in this journey. In the coming academic year, the new Upper Elementary environment ‘Lilac’ will be functional too.

Every class is observed and feedback for improvement is given to the teachers of all classes. The Montessorians from Navadisha, the Principal and the Coordinator observe classes. The teachers also have peer observation twice a year to learn best practices from each other. Additionally, every day after school, the teachers gather in one environment, read a chapter of Maria Montessori and then do one presentation and brainstorm on the philosophy behind it.

Our little learners stepped out with curiosity and confidence, with a prepared list in hand they picked fresh fruits & vegetables, bought essential stationery and practiced real-life skills like choosing, counting, paying and financial literacy, it was a simple outing... yet a meaningful lesson in independence, awareness, and practical learning!

On 2nd October 2025, the new batch of our Pre Montessori students attended Vidyarambam on the auspicious occasion of Vijayadashami and are attending school for a few hours every day since then.

Presentation Days are a part of the Elementary Montessori ways. This year each Elementary environment presented three fairy tales namely the Princess and the Pea by Aquamarine, Rapunzel by Olive and The Sleeping Beauty by Saffron to their parents. From the choice of the fairy tale to the discussion of characters, dialogues and props everything was student led. The parents were surprised and happy on seeing their wards so comfortable and confident on stage. These Presentation days will continue with Ted Talks, poem recitations, story narration and much more
