A reminder will be sent for delayed payment. If the delay is beyond 30 days the parent will have to seek re-admission for the child.

GENERAL RULES AND DISCIPLINE

1. Every student should carry with him/her the school handbook every day.
2. Every student must wear clean & neat uniform as per the approved pattern. No relaxation is acceptable in this regard. General turn out of the student will be checked regularly.
3. ID card must be worn by the child everyday.
4. Attendance in the morning assembly is compulsory. All the students must reach the school on time (by 7.45 am), leave their books and other belongings in their respective rooms, attend roll call and then come down for the Open Assembly on Monday or attend class Assembly.
5. Students are not allowed to bring crackers, any sharp items, valuable items (such as smart watches, toys, cell phones, cameras) to the school. Once confiscated, it will not be returned and a fine of Rs. 1000/- will be levied.
6. Students will be required to pay for the wilful damage of school property.
7. The classrooms are not extensions of the playground and hence no play or running around shall be indulged in.
8. No parent or visitors may meet the teachers during the working hours of the school.
9. The parents/visitors may meet the Principal by appointment only.
10. School timings should be strictly adhered to (for timings see School Hours on Pg. 15). Habitual late comers will be fined. No student will be allowed to leave the school premises during school hours without a gate pass from the office. (Refer page 25) It will be considered half a day leave for 3 consecutive days of late coming.
11. It is mandatory to speak in English while the students are anywhere in the School Campus and in the School bus.
12. For birthdays, students can wear casual clothes only till Grade IV. Distribution of Chocolates will not be permitted.
13. Birthday parties, birthday cakes, special gifts to teachers / friends will not be permitted.

14. The child may gift a book/sapling to the school on his / her birthday. However, it is not compulsory.
15. Students are allowed to wear a simple analog / digital wrist watch from Grade V. Smart watches are not allowed.
16. Improper conduct reflecting character, persistent irregularity, continual neglect of studies, disobedience, insubordination and disrespect towards any staff member, malpractice at test and examinations, thieving, immoral behavior, smoking or chewing tobacco, use of drugs and liquor and other serious intentional offences are punishable by expulsion.
17. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline, by seeing that the children prepare their lessons and by taking an active interest in the activities of the school.
18. Parents/guardians are requested to notify the school of any change in their address, telephone numbers, e-mail id & aadhar card as soon as possible.
19. Parents/guardians are expected to ensure that their children / wards leave the school premises not later than fifteen minutes after the school gets over.
20. Parents are requested to read carefully all circular letters/notices issued on the NLP by the school from time to time, and take action promptly. Timely action on these is in the interest of the children.
21. All letters concerning children, except those of a personal nature, should be addressed to the "PRINCIPAL" by designation and not by name. It will be of great help if parents state in their letter the class and section of the child.
22. Attendance on the day of reopening is compulsory. Absence due to illness or any other reason should be intimated at once as prior permission is required even for a short period of a day or two. Long absence, without prior intimation, may result in the child's name being taken off from all the school records.
23. There are no facilities for private tuitions in the school. However, children who are weak in a particular subject / subjects are given extra guidance classes as and when considered necessary, or requested by parents in very special cases.

ADMISSIONS & WITHDRAWALS

1. Students of our school are expected to follow the curriculum prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.
2. Applications for admission should be made on the prescribed form by parents or guardian who will be responsible for the pupil's conduct, punctuality, regular attendance, progress in school and payment of fees and other matters.
3. A pupil will be given a test (Grade II to IX) at the time of admission. The decision of the school authorities regarding the entrance test shall be final.
4. A pupil who joins the school for the first time must produce a photocopy of the aadhar card and official birth certificate as evidence of the date of birth entered in the admission form. A child coming from another school must produce a transfer certificate from the school last attended.
5. A transfer certificate, or any other certificate, will be issued only if all the school dues have been paid and library books and school items have been returned. It will be issued 10 days after the last working day of the school
6. In the event of withdrawal of a child from the school after the commencement of a term, the entire term's fee will have to be remitted.
7. A handwritten requisition letter addressed to the Principal should be provided for TC within the window from Dec 22nd to Jan 13th, TC application after that date will invite a fine of Rs.10000 (be it transfer/ shifting of residence/any other reason may be)

TO ATTENTION OF THE PARENTS & GUARDIANS

1. Co-operate with the school and ensure effective learning.
2. Look into your child's Handbook every day and see that the assigned Home Work is done regularly.
3. If you feel or notice that your child is not making the desired progress, kindly meet the Principal. You are always welcome to the school to discuss about the progress of your child.
4. Address a leave application to the Principal through the class teacher prior to the absence of your child duly attested by you.

5. Ensure that your child attends school regularly in clean school uniform.
6. Ensure that your child carries necessary books, notebooks, worksheets according to the timetable. They should not carry things/books that are not required for the day.
7. Ensure that your child attends guidance classes, if necessary.
8. Ensure that your child brings home daily class work and note books as per the given schedule.
9. Check the school NLP every day for homework and other updates.
10. Ensure that their wards maintain worksheets and assessment sheets, classwork and homework and retain the same till the end of the academic year.
11. Weekly tests will be conducted in all subjects from grades VI - XII.
12. Do not send your child to school when he or she is ill.
13. All communication to be made through the ward's school diary only.
14. Ensure that your child is escorted safely to school and back home.
15. Carry out surprise checks of the bags of your child.
16. Attend all the meetings at schools for the welfare of your ward.
17. Leave your complete residential and official address along with phone number to the school for communication.
18. Sending money for payment of fee or any other reason through the child/cleaner/nanny/driver/teacher should be avoided.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A number of activities are planned for the students within the school hours. A list will be sent to the parents in the first week of June. The last block on Friday for Grades I to V and for Grades VI and above Saturday has been set aside for these activities. Activity once chosen cannot be changed. The same activity will be continued in the next year also.

HOUSE SYSTEM

Students are divided into 4 houses viz., EARTH, AIR, FIRE, WATER for all Sports, Cultural and academic activities. Change of house is not permitted.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities are designed to stimulate the interest of the students and provide opportunities for self expression thereby ensuring a balanced and integrated personality. Various clubs viz., Literary Club, ECO Club, Heritage Club, Knits & Knots Club, Quiz Club, Cookery Club, Robotics, Coding Club, Compassionate Club & Crochet Club

FIELD TRIPS

Students will be taken on Field trips to various places of educational value.

HOMEWORK

Homework is a very important part of the education process. It encourages children to study outside the school, helping them towards a point where they take responsibility for their own learning. It involves parents in their child's

education and, as much research indicates, this is as important to a child's success at school. It allows children to practise work taught in class. It develops skills in using the library and other learning sources.

The board discourages giving Home work for classes I & II. Hence Homework would be kept to a minimum of 10 to 15 minutes. However the higher classes will have Home work on a regular basis. (Refer page: 20)

The involvement of parents in this area is very important. We know that children's success at school is closely linked to their parents' interest and involvement in their education. So working in partnership with parents is very important to us. Parents are requested not to do the child's work or teach. If the child is unable to do the homework, he/she should get back to the teacher. Reading of daily lessons, learning new vocabulary and handwriting practice should happen everyday.

Tuition is a very poor replacement of a parents' time with the child. Tuitions will in no way be useful for a child but only be confusing for the child.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

The School has a separate dining area where the children will eat their lunch. Lunch should be brought by the child. However parents who bring the lunch later will need to hand it over to the security officer at the gate not later than 11 am. Parents will not be allowed to bring it to the lunch room. Please send enough drinking water. Avoid sending a very heavy lunch. Please include vegetables (raw) and fruits in the daily diet. A spoon / fork and a towel spread is a must. Students are not to bring Non-Veg food (Even Eggs).

Breakfast & Lunch from Chettinad Canteen is provided at school. Fee will be collected every month. Ordering for lunch in the morning will not work as food is outsourced and not cooked here and the number of packs is shared with them the previous day

CANTEEN

Canteen facility is available in the Senior Block for Students from Grade V.

Money is something everyone has to deal with sometime or other. It is necessary for Parents to teach their children the value of money -Saving, Spending and Responsibility.



LIBRARY

1. All students of the school are members of the School Library.
2. Strict discipline and silence are to be observed in the Library and Reading Room.
3. Students from class III onwards can borrow one book at a time.
4. The Library will be kept open from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm on all working days.
5. Books from the Library should be properly looked after and deposited on the due date.
6. Marking cutting and dog-eared pages of the books are strictly prohibited.
7. Text books, Reference books, Journals and Periodicals are to be read in the Library only. These are not meant to be taken home.
8. The librarian may recall a book at any time in case of urgency.
9. Books from the library are to be returned at least a week before leaving the station or any break and one month before any vacation.
10. A 'No Due Certificate' by each student is to be obtained from the Librarian while withdrawing any student from school. In case of the loss of borrowed books, the student must either replace the book of the same kind or pay triple the cost of the book to the Librarian.
11. Read the newspapers and magazines regularly. Do not mark, underline or annotate them.
12. Each classroom will also have a Library corner with ample reading material.

SAFETY POLICY

SCHOOL ACCESS

- We strive to ensure our school is welcoming while at the same time secure and safe for pupils, staff and visitors alike.
- School arrival time is between 7.30 and 7.45 am. Early arrival before 7.30 will not be entertained. Late arrival beyond 7.50 am will not be entertained. Students those who come late for 3 consecutive days will lose half a day attendance in the same month.
- After the first bell, parents / Guardians should leave the premises and the house keeping staff will lock the gates to ensure pupil's safety.

- A **Pickup card** has been issued to all parents. Keep it safely and whoever is coming to school or school bus to pick up the child must carry it. It will be renewed once in 2 years. It is not to be photo copied. Buy extra copies from the school office.
- If pupils are to be allowed for hospital appointments or other reasons they must be picked up from the school office by a relative or a nominated responsible adult. A note and the Pickup card must be sent by the parent for the school to be able to allow the pupil with confidence. Pupils can be picked up only at 12.00 noon 2.30 pm.
- Please ensure that your emergency contact details are regularly updated so that you can be contacted in the event of an emergency.
- A gate pass must be collected at the school office and handed over to the security when taking a child in the middle of a session.
- Please ensure that the students do not bring any sharp instruments such as knife, blade and such to school.

RULES IN CASE OF ABSENCE

1. No leave of absence will be granted for part of a working day, except under special circumstances.
2. Absentees without prior permission on rejoining school must produce a leave slip (Pages 119-142) from their parents or guardians explaining the cause of absence.
3. Students afflicted by infectious diseases must complete the quarantine period before rejoining school. This should be indicated in the Medical certificate.
4. The Principal's permission is essential for leave exceeding three days. Informing the school about the students' absence is mandatory.
5. 80% of attendance is a must for promotion to the next class.
6. Students who are sick will not be permitted to attend school only for tests/Exams.

LOCKERS

- A Single locker will be allotted for each child from Grade VI. This is for them to store their notebooks, books and stationery. The key is to be handed over to the teacher-in-charge. The lockers will not be broken if the keys are lost.
- Teachers will help them to use it wisely. They will be inspected regularly.

BONAFIDE CERTIFICATE

- Parents should produce a request letter and a passport size photo of the ward and collect the bonafide after 2 working days. It will not be issued immediately. It will be issued only once in a year. Only the address in our school records will be used.

SCHOOL BUS

The School transport service will be available for those who would like to avail it, subject to its route being programmed by school authorities.

- School bus drop off and pickup points are to be noted by the parents.
- If there is a change of residence, parents should give it in writing in advance and check on the nearest pickup point of the school bus.
- Bus fees will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- If the child availing school bus needs to be picked up from the school by the parent or a nominated responsible adult a note should be sent. Telephone instructions will not be entertained.
- Parents are to note down the mobile numbers of the school bus drivers.
- Parents, Guardians or Drivers coming to pickup the children should carry the Pickup card and the Transport sticker provided by the school.
- Private Cab Operator: Idaya travels for "Door to Door" pickup & Drop facility is available. Kindly contact school office.

BUS RULES

Bus Safety depends upon students co-operation with the driver, conductor and nanny. It is impossible for the driver to concentrate on the road when students misbehave. The Bus is considered as an extension of the School and the following code of conduct is required.

1. Students must remain seated
2. Tampering with the bus or any of its equipment is prohibited, failing which the cost of damage will be collected from the students responsible.
3. Communicating in regional language is prohibited.
4. Students must ride in their assigned bus and depart only at the assigned stop.
5. If a student's code of conduct is not up to our expectation he/she will not be given school transportation any more.

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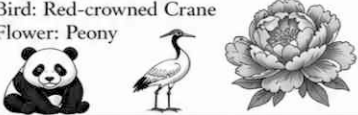

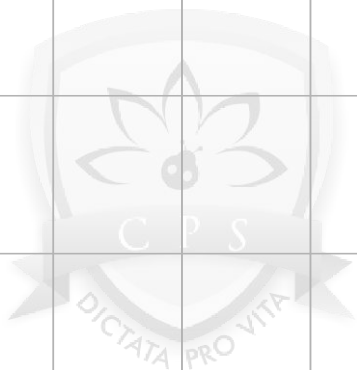
